

Sherborne Open Exhibition 2022

The Sherborne Open Art Exhibition is open to all.

Works will be chosen by a panel of three selectors. There is no guarantee of selection, but works will be chosen on the basis of interest and representing the region, as well as quality of execution.

Entry Requirements and terms for Exhibition works

2D and 3D Works: Maximum of 3. No more than 1 not for sale.

2D Works: Must be sturdily framed, or on a canvas with no staples or tacks visible when hung. If unframed the sides should be presentable. Drips or marks may negatively affect the judge's decision.

Pictures should be ready for hanging with D-Rings and cord (see picture)
Any sharp or abrasive areas on the back will have to be replaced or covered.

For emergencies we will have some hanging materials and tools available during the handing in times, but please remember, our volunteers cannot take responsibility for any damage or other problems.

Sculpture: No utility pottery or craftwork. Attach labels as above where possible

There is no maximum size, but please bear in mind, the display boards are 1.2metres (4 feet) wide each.

No refunds will be given if we are unable to hang work because it does not conform to the specifications or it is not selected.

Labelling:



Each picture should have two labels attached.

One fixed to the back, the other on a string so that it can be visible over the top for when we compile the catalogue, but not long enough to be visible beneath the picture when we put them back.

Each label should show:

Your name

Your contact number and email

Title

Medium

Price

The email you receive after your submission will have the titles and prices you entered. You can print this and cut your labels from it. Please make sure it has your name and contact details.

Folio Works: Maximum of 3. At least 1 must be for sale.

Folio works will be displayed in the browsers.

They can be original works or archival prints, eg Giclee prints.

Laser copies or inkjet prints will not be accepted.

They must be in cellophane with a firm backing board (and preferably a mount)

Labelling:

A label must be attached to the back.

Each label should show:

Your name

Your contact number and email

Title

Medium

Price

The email you receive after your submission will have the titles and prices you entered. You can print this and cut your labels from it. Please make sure it has your name and contact details.

Sales: Sherborne Open Art Exhibition charges a commission of 25% on each sale.

Payments will be made by 12th August.

Submission.

Handing in days.

You are welcome to submit your entries and pay on the day, we are also offering the opportunity to register your work online for fast-track hand in.

For fast track hand-in, submissions can be made online at www.sherbornearts.org.

Here you can fill in the details of the works you wish to enter, and pay for your entries (membership included).

Once your entries have been submitted, you will receive an email confirming your entry, including the details of each work in a printable format for use as labels.

At handing in, you will be able to bring your work straight to the hand in desk.

Collection: Any work not collected at the end of the exhibition (except by prior arrangement) may incur a charge. Unselected work may not be removed before the end of the exhibition.

Handing-back Day: Sunday 31st July, from 2 to 4pm.

Terms and Conditions for all entries:

I understand there is a selection process and that there is no guarantee of my works being shown.

I also understand that Sherborne Art Open Exhibition cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to any of my works submitted for the exhibition, however or whenever caused, and will not recompense me for the loss of artworks.

We will endeavour to take good care of all submissions.

We recommend Artists take out insurance with an organisation such as the SAA (Society for All Artists)
